ORDER

On October 11, 2007, the International Association of Fire Fighters (“Union”) filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes the probationary fire fighters, career fire fighters, career fire lieutenants and career fire captains employed by the Town of Williston (“Employer”). The Employer agreed to the conducting of an election among these employees.

On November 28, 2007, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election among these employees in the training room of the Town of Williston Fire Station. There were no observers present during the election. All four eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the International Association of Fire Fighters. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that the International Association of Fire Fighters is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the probationary fire fighters, career fire fighters, career fire lieutenants and career fire captains employed by the Town of Williston.
