CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on October 24, 1968.

1. On July 30, 1968, the parties filed with the State Labor Relations Board a Stipulation for a consent election of collective bargaining representatives for a bargaining unit of the employees of the City of Burlington Fire Department consisting of all employees of the Department, with the exception of supervisory personnel which were designated to be the Lieutenants, Captains, First and Second Assistant Chiefs and the Fire Chief.

2. On September 20, 1968, an election was held at the Central Station of the Burlington Fire Department in Burlington, Vermont under the supervision of William Kemsley, and John Boylan, members of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. The employees of the bargaining unit were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented as exclusive bargaining agent by the Burlington Fire Fighters Association.

The result of the vote was: Yes, 48;; No, 1; Absent, 1; Ill, 1; Vacation, 1; No Vote, 1.

Now therefore it is hereby ORDERED that the Burlington Fire Fighters Association Inc. is hereby certified as the collective bargaining representative of all employees of the Burlington City Fire Department, with the exception of supervisory employees

as above defined.
