CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on October 7, 1969.

1. On April 21, 1969, and September 22, 1969 the Board made Findings and Orders in the above entitled matter whereby it was determined that all of the members of the Barre City Fire Department were eligible for membership in the petitioning union with the exception of the chief of said department.

2. On October 2, 1969 the parties filed a stipulation with the Board in which the petitioner was recognized as the exclusive bargaining agent for all of the members of the Barre City Fire Department with the exception of the chief.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the International Association of Firefighters AFL-CIO, CLC Local Union No. 881 is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all of the members of the Barre City Fire Department with the exception of the chief. The bargaining unit shall consist of the deputy chief, captain, two lieutenants and all firefighters of the Barre City Fire Department.


