ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 5, 1980, a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative was filed with the Vermont Labor Relations Board by the Springfield Fire Fighters Local #2750 pursuant to 21 V.S.A. §1724(a)(1).

A unit determination hearing was held on May 1, 1980, and on June 19, 1980, as a result of that hearing, the Board ordered that an appropriate bargaining unit include the non-rank firefighters and the lieutenants of the Town of Springfield Fire Department [Springfield Fire Fighters Local #2750, International Association of Fire Fighters and Town of Springfield, 3 VLRB 237 (1980)].

Pursuant to the Board's order, a secret ballot election was held on July 2, 1980, at 2:00 p.m. in the firehouse at Hartness Ave., Springfield, Vermont. Assistant to the Board Marilyn Jeffrey conducted the election. Fire Fighter/EMT John Wood observed the balloting for the Petitioner. Assistant to the Town Manager William Steele observed for the Town.


The balloting concluded at 3:00 p.m. with all eligible voters participating in the election. The ballots were counted in the presence of the observers. The results were:
