ORDER OF NONCERTIFICATION

On August 25, 2006, the United Steelworkers, AFL-CIO ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent all employees of the Town of Danville Highway Department and the Assistant Town Clerk of the Town of Danville. On September 8, 2006, the Town of Danville ("Employer") filed a response to the petition and agreed to the conducting of a representation election among these employees.

On September 27, 2006, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election in the Selectboard Meeting Room, Town Hall, Danville, Vermont. Mert Leonard, Administrative Assistant for the Employer, observed the election for the Employer. Sharon Daniell observed for the Union. All six employees agreed to by the parties as eligible voters in the election cast ballots.

Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the United Steelworkers, AFL-CIO. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that the United Steelworkers, AFL-CIO, is not certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of all employees of the Town of Danville Highway Department and the Assistant Town Clerk of the Town of Danville.
