CERTIFICATION

An election having been held under the direction of the Board pursuant to the following notice:

Notice of Election
July 11, 1978

The Vermont Labor Relations Board has ordered, in accordance with the agreement of the parties entered into at a regularly scheduled hearing before the Board on July 6, 1978, that an election will be held by the Board among all non-supervisory employees of Barre City government who are not now members of Local 1369, AFSCME; Local 881, IAFF, or the Police Officers Local, in order to determine whether or not these employees wish to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes.

The election will take place between 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon in the City Council Chamber, Barre City Hall, and between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. in Mr. Balzanelli's office, Barre City Auditorium.

And the following question having been voted on:

Do you wish to be represented for collective bargaining purposes by a Collective Bargaining Unit composed of all non-supervisory employees of Barre City government who are not now members of Local 1369, AFSCME; Local 881, IAFF; or the Police Officers Local? Yes _____ No _____


The Board certifies the results of voting on that question to be: Yes - 9 , No - 7.

ORDER

Now therefore, it is ORDERED: If, within 30 days, the City of Barre voluntarily recognizes a bargaining unit to represent those entitled to vote, that unit shall be the Collective

Bargaining Unit pursuant to 17 V.S.A., Sec. 1724 for those employees, and no further election need be held. The Unit and the City shall so certify to the Board. Provided if within 10 days after such certification 30% of the members of the Unit petition for a different bargaining representative, further proceedings will be ordered.
