Order of Certification

On February 3, 1981, Local 300, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, through James D. Merrigan, petitioned the Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for the linemen and metermen employed by Northfield Electric Department.

By letter dated April 14, 1981 from James D. Merrigan and letter dated April 24, 1981 from Edgar C. Gadbois, Northfield Municipal Manager, both agreed to the appropriate bargaining unit.

A consent election was conducted on May 11, 1981 by Board Assistant Timothy J. Noonan. There were no observers present during the voting; however, James Merrigan and Village Clerk Richard L. Cleveland were present at the counting of the ballots by Mr. Noonan. A total of five ballots were cast and the tally was:

As a result of this election, the Labor Relations Board hereby ORDERS Local 300, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers CERTIFIED as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for the linemen and metermen of the Northfield Electric Department.
