ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On January 22, 1991, Local 1201, AFSCME, AFL-CIO ("Union"), filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to add the Transfer Station Attendant employed by the Town of Castleton ("Town") to the existing bargaining unit of Town employees represented by the Union. In a response filed February 1, 1991, the Town agreed to a consent election.

Carroll Comstock, Labor Relations Board Member, conducted an election on March 4, 1991, in the Conference Room at Town of Castleton offices, Castleton, Vermont. Ralph Crippen, AFSCME Organizer, was present as an observer for the Union. Lisa Lewis observed for the Town. The one eligible employee voted. The results of the election were:


As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED:


Police Department, excluding the Foreman of the Highway
