ORDER

On June 14, 1994, the Barre Town Association of Professional Emergency Medical Technicians ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among all full-time emergency medical technicians employed by the Town of Barre Department of Emergency Medical Services.


The Town of Barre ("Employer") agreed to the conducting of a consent election among these employees. Timothy Noonan, Labor Relations Board Executive Director, conducted an election on August 3, 1994, in the Selectboard Meeting Room in the Town of Barre Municipal Building, Websterville, Vermont. Carl Rogers, Barre Town Manager, was present during the latter half of the election as an observer for the Employer. The Association had no observer. The employees were asked on the election ballot whether they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Barre Town Association of Professional Emergency Medical Technicians. All eight eligible employees voted. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED that the Barre Town Association of Professional Emergency Medical Technicians is NOT CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative of the full-time emergency medical technicians employed by the Town of Barre Department of Emergency Medical Services.
