ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On July 17, 1995, the Barre Town Association of Emergency Medical Technicians ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative. The Association requested an election among all full-time emergency medical technicians employed by the Town of Barre ("Employer").

The Employer responded to the petition on July 31, 1995, and agreed to the conducting of a consent election among this group of employees. On August 25, 1995, Timothy Noonan, Executive Director for the Vermont Labor Relations Board, conducted an election in the Selectboard Meeting Room in the Town of Barre Municipal Building, Websterville, Vermont. Neither the Association nor the Employer had an observer. Four of five eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Barre Town Association of Emergency Medical Technicians. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED that the Barre Town Association of Emergency Medical Technicians is CERTIFIED as the exclusive


