ORDER


Whereas, the Vermont Labor Relations Board issued an order on December 5, 1996, certifying the Burlington Police Officers' Association ("Association") as the exclusive bargaining representative of the sergeants of the Burlington Police Department, and adding the sergeants to the existing bargaining unit of Burlington Police Department employees represented by the Association, pursuant to the Association and the City of Burlington ("City") agreeing to the inclusion of the sergeants in the bargaining unit (VLRB Docket No. 96-50); and


Whereas, the City and the Association jointly filed a unit clarification petition with the Labor Relations Board on May 11, 2001, requesting that the order of certification issued on December 5, 1996, be amended to reflect the agreement of the City and the Association to remove the sergeants from the bargaining unit represented by the Association because they are supervisory employees:


Now therefore, it is hereby ordered that the sergeants of the Burlington Police Department are removed from the bargaining unit of Burlington Police Department employees represented by the Burlington Police Officers' Association, and the Association is decertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the sergeants.
