O R D E R
DOCKET NO. 50-18

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on January 14, 1974.

1. The parties filed a Stipulation dated November 19, 1973 and then an amended Stipulation dated December 14, 1973, agreeing to a consent election on the issue of decertification of the Rutland Police Benevolent Association and the question of certification of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 1201.

2. Pursuant to said Stipulations an election was held in Rutland on January 11, 1974 under the supervision of Alfred J. Schmitt, member of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. All patrolmen, dispatchers and metermaids of the Rutland Police Department were eligible to vote. 28 of the eligible employees voted upon the following question with respect to decertification.

Whether or not the employees (Patrolmen and Women) of the Police Department wish to rescind (terminate) the authority of the Police Benevolent Association to act as their exclusive Bargaining Unit.

The result of the vote was yes: 22, no: 6.

The said employees also voted on the second question of certification as follows:

Whether or not the aforesaid employees wish to be represented by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO Local 1201.

The result of the vote was yes: 23, no: 5.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Rutland Police Benevolent Association is hereby decertified as the exclusive bargaining unit for the aforesaid employees of the Rutland Police Department. The American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local 1201 is hereby certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the eligible employees of the Police Department of the City Rutland, Vermont.
