CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on October 14, 1971.

1. The parties filed with the State Labor Relations Board a Stipulation for a Consent Election of exclusive Collective bargaining representative for a bargaining unit consisting of the patrolmen of the Police Department of the City of South Burlington, Vermont.

2. On Oct. 11, 1971 an election was held in the City of South Burlington, Vermont under the supervision of William Kemsley and Alfred Schmitt, members of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. Sixteen patrolmen of the City of South Burlington Police Department were eligible to vote. Eleven patrolmen voted and five were not present to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by Local No. 334 International Brotherhood of Police Officers.

The result of the vote was: 11 Yes.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the International Brotherhood of Police Officers Local No. 334 is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining

representative of all the patrolmen of the Police Department of the City of South Burlington, Vermont.
