ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On March 26, 1982, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, through Edward E. Ryan, petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for all members of the Town of Milton Police Department excluding the Chief and Corporal. On April 5, 1982, the Milton Board of Selectmen unanimously agreed to a consent election to determine a collective bargaining representative.

A consent election was conducted by Board Assistant Timothy Noonan on May 21, 1982. Observers were Barry Habecker for the Union and Ernest Laird for the Town. A total of ten (10) votes was cast; the tally was:

No union	1




