CERTIFICATION OF VOLUNTARY RECOGNITION

WHEREAS, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO ("AFSCME") petitioned the Labor Relations Board on January 29, 1986, to certify AFSCME as exclusive bargaining representative for the officers of the Bennington Police Department excluding the Chief, Captains, Lieutenants and Sergeants; and excluding all employees serving as clerks, dispatchers or secretaries for the Department; and

WHEREAS, the petitioned-for employees are currently represented by the Bennington Police Association; and

WHEREAS, AFSCME has demonstrated the members of the Bennington Police Association have elected to be represented by AFSCME; and

WHEREAS, the Bennington Police Association has expressed no objection to AFSCME being certified as bargaining representative; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Bennington has agreed to voluntarily recognize AFSCME as the bargaining representative of the petitioned-for employees; and


WHEREAS, no rival employee organization is seeking to represent the same group of employees, it is hereby ORDERED:

The American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO is CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative for the officers of the Bennington Police Department, excluding the Chief, Captains, Lieutenants and Sergeants; and excluding all employees serving as clerks, dispatchers or secretaries for the Department.
