ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On October 9, 1986, Local 2413, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among all full-time employees of the City of Newport Police Department, excluding the Chief.

On October 21, 1986, the City of Newport ("City") notified the Board it agreed to the composition of the bargaining unit proposed by the Union and agreed to a consent election.

The Labor Relations Board conducted a representation election on November 18, 1986, in the City Council Room of the Newport Municipal Building. Timothy Noonan, Board Executive Director, conducted the election. Peter Robinson, City Manager, observed the election for the City. Ralph Crippen, Union Representative, observed for the Union.

The results of the election were:



As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED:




