ORDER OF DECERTIFICATION

WHEREAS Local 200, Service Employees' International Union, AFL-CIO ("Union") was certified on October 16, 1986, by the Vermont Labor Relations Board subsequent to a representation election as the exclusive bargaining representative of the full-time police officers and full-time police dispatchers employed by the Town of Wilmington Police Department; and

WHEREAS a group of employees of the Wilmington Police Department filed a petition on April 1, 1988, with the Labor Relations Board to decertify the Union as the exclusive bargaining representative of the police officers and police dispatchers; and

WHEREAS there is no collective bargaining agreement in effect between the Union and the Town of Wilmington; and

WHEREAS the Union informed the Labor Relations Board on April 19, 1988, that it was disclaiming interest in representing the full-time police officers and full-time police dispatchers employed by the Wilmington Police Department:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Local 200, Service Employees' International Union, AFL-CIO is DECERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative of the full-time police officers and full-time police dispatchers employed by the Town of Wilmington Police Department.
