CERTIFICATION OF VOLUNTARY RECOGNITION

WHEREAS, the Barre Town Police Benevolent Association filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative on May 1, 1991, seeking to represent all members of the Town of Barre Police Department (i.e., patrol officers, sergeants and dispatchers), excluding the Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, AFSCME Local 1369, AFL-CIO, the incumbent bargaining representative of the employees, notified the Vermont Labor Relations Board on May 29, 1991, that it was disclaiming any interest in representing the employees; and




Department (i.e., patrol officers, sergeants and dispatchers),




ORDER OF CLARIFICATION

It is hereby ORDERED that the Certification of Voluntary Recognition issued by the Vermont Labor Relations Board on June 13, 1991, in this matter, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is CLARIFIED to explicitly provide that the June 13, 1991, Certification of Voluntary Recognition amends the Order of Certification issued by the Board on March 17, 1989, in Docket No. 88-37, to the extent that AFSCME Local 1369, AFL-CIO, no longer is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the patrol officers, sergeants and dispatchers employed by the Town of Barre Police Department, and AFSCME Local 1369, AFL-CIO, remains certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of Town of Barre Department of Public Works employees.
