ORDER

WHEREAS, the Vermont Labor Relations Board issued an Order on November 25, 1977, certifying the Stowe Police Officers Association as the exclusive bargaining representative of the sergeants, police officers and dispatchers of the Stowe Police Department (VLRB Docket No. 78-2R); and

WHEREAS, the Vermont Labor Relations Board issued an Order on April 29, 1993, in VLRB Docket No. 93-6, amending the Order of Certification issued by the Board on November 25, 1977, to provide that "the Stowe Police Officers Association, affiliated with AFSCME Local 1369, Council 93", is the exclusive bargaining representative of the sergeants, police officers and dispatchers of the Stowe Police Department (16 VLRB 145); and


WHEREAS, the Stowe Police Officers Association filed a petition with the Labor Relations Board on December 9, 1994, requesting that the Order of Certification issued by the Board on April 29, 1993, be amended to remove the affiliation of the Stowe Police Officers Association with AFSCME Local 1369, Council 93, pursuant to a vote of members of the Stowe Police Officers Association; and

WHEREAS, AFSCME Local 1369, Council 93, informed the Labor Relations Board on December 14, 1994, that it was requesting that it be allowed to withdraw as representative of the involved employees:


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Order of Certification issued by the Vermont Labor Relations Board on April 29, 1993, in Docket No. 93-6, is amended to provide that the Stowe Police Officers Association is no longer affiliated with AFSCME Local 1369, Council 93, and that the Stowe Police Officers Association is the exclusive bargaining representative of the sergeants, police officers and dispatchers of the Stowe Police Department.
