ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On May 20, 1996, Vermont AFSCME Council 93, Local 1201 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes all part time and full time police officers employed by the City of Vergennes ("Employer").

On June 4, 1996, the Employer agreed to the conducting of a consent election among these employees. On June 18, 1996, Linda McIntire, Legal Assistant/Election Officer for the Vermont Labor Relations Board, conducted an election in the fire station meeting room, Vergennes, Vermont. City Manager Mel Hawley observed for the Employer; Police Officer Dwight Burton observed for the Union. All five eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by Vermont AFSCME Council 93, Local 1201. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED that Vermont AFSCME Council 93, Local 1201 is CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative


