ORDER

WHEREAS, as a result of a representation election, Vermont AFSCME Council 93, Local 1201 ("Union") was certified on July 3, 1996, as the exclusive bargaining representative of all part-time and full-time police officers employed by the City of Vergennes (See Vermont Labor Relations Board Docket No. 96-46); and

WHEREAS, on May 26, 1997, Donald Ploof filed a Petition for Decertification of Collective Bargaining Representative asserting that he was the only remaining member of the bargaining unit represented by the Union and that he requested decertification of the Union as exclusive bargaining representative; and


WHEREAS, the Union and the City of Vergennes have confirmed that Donald Ploof is the only employee in the bargaining unit at present; and

WHEREAS, the Union has informed the Labor Relations Board that it does not contest its decertification as bargaining representative and does not request a representation election:


NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Vermont AFSCME Council 93, Local 1201 is decertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the police officer employed by the City of Vergennes.


