CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on October 10, 1973.

1. On September 13, 1973, the parties filed a Stipulation for a consent election of the exclusive collective bargaining representative for the money counters and mutual department employees of Green Mountain Racing Corporation.

2. On September 29, 1973, an election was held at the Green Mountain Park Race Track in Pownal, Vermont, under the supervision of Alfred J. Schmitt, member of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. 137 eligible employees of the bargaining unit voted upon the following question.

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by Local 200 Service Employees International Union, AFL-CIO?

The results of the vote were, Yes, 71; No, 65.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Local 200 Service Employees International Union, AFL-CIO is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all of the money counters and mutual department employees of Green Mountain Racing Corporation with the exception of supervisory employees.
