**CERTIFICATION
ORDER**

**This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor
Relations Board on April 10, 1968.**

**1. On March 8, 1968 the International Brotherhood of Electrical
Workers, AFL-CIO-CLC and Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. filed with the
State Labor Relations Board a stipulation for a Consent Election of
collective bargaining representatives for a bargaining union of the
employees of the Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. designated as
'Production Employees' consisting of twenty one members.**

**2. On April 5, 1968 an election was held at the office of
Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. in South Burlington, under the supervision of
William Kenesley and John Boylan, members of the State Labor Relations
Board.**

**3. The employees of the bargaining unit were asked to vote
on the following question:**

**Do you wish to be represented as
sole collective bargaining agency
by Local #308, International Brotherhood
of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO and CLC.**

The result of the vote was YES fifteen, NO five, (one employee was no longer a member of the bargaining union.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Local #300, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, AFL-CIO and CLC is hereby certified as the collective bargaining representatives of the bargaining union termed "production employees" of Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. Said production employees bargaining union consist of the following:

 - 4. Measurement and Control:
 - Meter man - 2
 - Meter tector - 1
 - 5. St. Albans division:
 - Service chief - 1
