ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

This matter was brought before the Board through a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative on February 28, 1978 by Carla Thomas, President of the Vermont Federation of Teachers on behalf of Northeast Kingdom School Bus Drivers Federation. The petition was answered by Wall's Transportation Service through its attorney, John J. Wall, Jr. on March 26, 1979.

Pursuant to an agreement reached by both parties on April 5, 1979, the Board ordered an election to be held on April 11, 1979 at Wall's Transportation Service offices in West Burke, Vermont; all employees of Wall's Transportation Service who drove school busses in Caledonia County excluding the dispatcher and manager would be eligible to vote.

The election was conducted by Ms. Amy Kinzel, paralegal for the Board. Mr. Bruce Benoit served as observer for Wall's Transportation Service and Ms. Carla Thomas observed for the union. After the election the votes were counted with the following results: Four voted for the Northeast Kingdom School Bus Drivers Federation, and one voted for no union.

As a result of the foregoing election, it is ORDERED that Northeast Kingdom School Bus Drivers, VFT, AFT, AFL-CIO, be certified, and it hereby is, the exclusive collective bargaining representative for those employees of Wall's Transportation Service in West Burke, Vermont who drive school busses in Caledonia County excluding the dispatcher and manager.
