ORDER OF NO CERTIFICATION

On November 19, 1982, Teamsters Local Union No. 597, through Charles Raymond, petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for the drivers and dispatchers employed by the Yellow and Checker Cab Company. In answering the petition, Attorney William H. Sorrell, representing the Yellow and Checker Cab Company, questioned whether the Union had presented a sufficient number of currently valid authorization cards. After reviewing a current list of drivers and dispatchers employed by the Cab Company, the Board was satisfied that the cards on file were timely and that there was a statutorily sufficient showing of interest. Whereupon the Yellow and Checker Cab Company agreed to a consent election.

The consent election was conducted by Board Assistant Timothy Noonan on March 1, 1983, at the Cab Company premises in Burlington. Earl Nolan, Teamster business agent, observed the election for the Union; Robert Fletcher, owner of the Cab Company, observed for the Company.

Twenty-four votes were cast and the tally was:

No Union	18
"Spoiled" Ballots	2

The employees having determined that the Union is not the choice of the majority of the unit, it is hereby ORDERED that there be NO CERTIFICATION of the Teamsters Local Union No. 597 as the exclusive bargaining representative for the drivers and dispatchers employed by Yellow and Checker Cab Company.
