ORDER

WHEREAS, Local 1343, AFSCME, AFL-CIO ("Union") presently is the exclusive bargaining representative of all eligible Police Department employees and all full-time employees in the Highway, Sewer, Building and Grounds, Water and Finance Departments; excluding the recreation director, Sewer Department chief operating engineer and Highway Department superintendent; of the Town of Shelburne (Labor Relations Board Docket Nos. 93-15, 96-66 and 98-56); and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2000 the Union notified the Labor Relations Board that the Union disclaims any interest in remaining the representative of employees of the Town Highway Department, Water Department and Finance Department effective upon the expiration of the current collective bargaining agreement between the Town and Union on June 30, 2000 ; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2000, the Union filed with the Labor Relations Board signed and dated statements from the Town Highway Department, Water Department and Finance Department employees in the bargaining unit represented by the Union indicating that they no longer wished to be represented by the Union; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2000, the Union requested that the Order of Certification issued by the Board in Docket No. 98-56 be amended effective July 1, 2000,


so that the Union no longer is the representative of the employees of the Town Highway Department, Water Department and Finance Department; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Shelburne notified the Labor Relations Board on February 11, 2000, that the Town did not object to the Order of Certification being so amended:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that, effective upon the date the current collective bargaining agreement between Local 1343, AFSCME, AFL-CIO and the Town of Shelburne no longer is in effect, the Order of Certification issued by the Labor Relations Board on January 7, 1999, shall be amended to provide that Local 1343, AFSCME, AFL-CIO shall be decertified as the exclusive bargaining representative of employees of the Town of Shelburne Highway Department, Water Department and Finance Department; and that Local 1343, AFSCME, AFL-CIO shall remain certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of all eligible Police Department employees and all full-time employees in the Sewer, and Building and Grounds Departments; excluding the Sewer Department chief operating engineer; of the Town of Shelburne.
