ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 4, 2005, IBEW Local 300 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes all employees of the Town of Morristown Highway Department ("Employer") with the exception of the Highway Department Superintendent. The Employer agreed to the conducting of an election among these employees.

On April 1, 2005, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election among these employees in the Town Conference Room, Town Municipal Building, Morristown, Vermont. Union President George Clain and employee Michael Day observed the election for the Union. Town Administrator Francis Taginski was Employer observer for part of the balloting, and observed the counting of ballots. Twelve of thirteen eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by IBEW Local 300. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that IBEW Local 300 is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of all employees of the Town of Morristown

Highway Department with the exception of the Highway Department Superintendent.
