ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On January 30, 2007, the Chauffeurs, Teamsters, Warehousemen and Helpers Local 597 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes the truck drivers, equipment operators, laborers and lead hands of the Town of Warren Highway Department ("Employer"). The Employer agreed to the conducting of an election among these employees.

On April 4, 2007, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan and Board Clerk Melinda Moz-Knight conducted an election among these employees in the Town Hall, Warren, Vermont. Anthony White was Union observer during the election. The Employer had no observer. All five eligible employees voted. The employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Chauffeurs, Teamsters, Warehousemen and Helpers Local 597. The results of the election were:
