ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On February 26, 2018, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 300 ("Union"), filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to represent the laborer, truck driver, equipment operator and truck driver/equipment operator of the Town of Hyde Park ("Employer"). The Employer responded to the petition on March 14, 2018, agreeing to the conducting of a representation election among these employees.

On April 17, 2018, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election among these employees in the lower level meeting room of the Town of Hyde Park Municipal Offices, Hyde Park, Vermont. Jeffrey Wimette, Business Manager and Financial Secretary of the Union, observed the election for the Union. The Employer had no observer. All three eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 300. The results of the election were:
