CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on August 31, 1972.

1. On July 13, 1972, the State Labor Relations Board issued an order that an election would be conducted by the Board to determine whether or not five employees of the Street Department and two employees of the Sewer Plant of the Village of Essex Junction desired to have the Petitioner represent them as exclusive bargaining representative.

2. On August 23, 1972, an election was held in the Village of Essex Junction, Vermont, under the supervision of Alfred J. Schmitt, member of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. Five employees of the Street Department and two employees of the Sewer Plant of the Village of Essex Junction, were eligible to vote and were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be representative for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by International Brotherhood Teamsters Local 597.


One of the seven eligible voters did not vote. The result of the vote was: yes, 4; no, 2.


NOW THEREFORE it is hereby ORDERED that the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 597 is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative of the eligible employees of the Street Department and Sewer Plant of the Village of Essex Junction, Vermont.
