CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on December 1, 1975.

1. On November 3, 1975 the State Labor Relations Board issued Findings and Order with respect to the designation of a bargaining unit in the Village of Essex Junction consisting of the eligible employees of the Street Department, Sewer Department Police Dispatchers, Maintenance workers and Clerical workers.

2. On November 17, 1975 an election was held in the Village of Essex Junction, Vermont, under the supervision of Alfred J. Schmitt, member of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. Ten employees were eligible to vote and were asked to vote on the following question.

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO?


The result of the vote was that all ten employees voted yes.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local #1343 is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining

representative of a bargaining unit consisting of the employees of
the Street Department, Sewer Department, Police Dispatchers,
Maintenance workers and Clerical workers of the Village of Essex
Junction, Vermont.
