ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on April 30, 1975.

1. An earlier order of the Board designated the employees of the Burlington Electric Light Department generating plant as a bargaining unit. This order was appealed to the Supreme Court and the order of the Board was affirmed by the Supreme Court in the February term, 1975, in the case bearing Docket No. 253-73.

2. On April 24, 1975, an election was conducted by Alfred J. Schmitt, a member of the Board. The eligible employees of the bargaining unit were asked to vote individually with the dispatchers voting separately on the following question.

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by Local #300 International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers?


3. Thirty-one members of the bargaining unit voted. Twenty-two voted no and seven yes. A voted was taken separately of the two dispatchers both of whom voted no.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Petitioner

having failed to receive at least a 51% affirmative vote of all of the votes cast, that the Petitioner has failed to obtain the sufficient support to be certified. No election may be conducted in this bargaining unit or a subdivision within the next twelve months expiring April 24, 1976.
