CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on December 12, 1974.

1. The parties filed a Stipulation with the Board providing for the creation of a bargaining unit consisting of the linemen and groundmen of the Village of Ludlow Electric Light Department, that the Petitioner had the support of not less than 30% of the members of the proposed bargaining unit, and that the Board could conduct an election by secret ballot and certify the results to the parties.

2. On December 10, 1974, Alfred J. Schmitt, a member of the Board, conducted an election by secret ballot of the linemen and groundmen of the Light Department. Said employees were asked to vote on the following question.


Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by Local Union #300, International Brotherhood of Electrical workers?

3. Four employees were eligible to vote. The results of the vote were yes, 3; no, 1.

NOW THEREFORE, Local Union #300 International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers is hereby certified as the exclusive bargaining representative for a bargaining unit consisting of the linemen and groundmen of the Village of Ludlow Electric Light Department.
