ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the Vermont Labor Relations Board on September 10, 1976, and the following facts are found by the Board:

1. The parties filed a Stipulation for a Consent Election for exclusive bargaining representation for a bargaining unit of drivers, equipment operators, mechanics, maintenancemen and laborers, being the employees of the Town of Rockingham excluding all clerical, administrative and supervisory personnel. The Stipulation was dated September 14, 1976.

2. On September 23, 1976 an election was held in the Town of Rockingham, Vermont under the supervision of William Kemsley, a Member of the Vermont Labor Relations Board.

3. Thirteen (13) employees of the Town of Rockingham were eligible to vote and were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the Teamsters, Chauffeurs & Warehousemen, Local 597, IBTC&W?

- 4. The results of the vote were: No, 8; Yes, 2;
Blank ballot, 3.

As a result of the foregoing, it is ORDERED as follows, viz.:

That the Teamsters, Chauffeurs & Warehousemen, Local 597, IBTC&W, is not certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative for the employees of the Town of Rockingham.
