ORDER FOR DECERTIFICATION

This matter was brought before the Board by Petitioners Gary Pollender, Robert J. Lampert, Olin E. DeRosia and Audrey R. Patch, all employees of the Village of Ludlow Light Department. A hearing was held on January 3, 1979. Local 300, IBEW was represented by Charles Parent and the employees were represented by Attorney Douglas Richards. The employer was not represented. At the hearing the Board ordered that an election be held among all non-supervisory employees of the Village of Ludlow Light Department. As a result thereof and pursuant to a notice dated January 8, 1979, an election was held on January 17, 1979 between 3:30 p.m. and 3:45 p.m. in the Electric Light Building, Ludlow, Vermont.

The election was conducted by Board Member William G. Kemsley, Sr. Observer for either (or both) the employees petitioning for decertification and the management was John H. Adams and Charles Parent was an observer for Local 300, I.B.E.W.

After the election the votes were counted with the following results:

Local 300, I.B.E.W.	- One (1)
No Union	- Four (4)

As a result of the foregoing election, it is ORDERED that Local 300, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, be DECERTIFIED as the exclusive collective bargaining representative

of the non-supervisory employees of the Village of Ludlow Light
Department, and it hereby is.
