An election having been held under the direction of the Board pursuant to the following notice:

Consent Election Notice

Pursuant to agreement between the Petitioner, AFSCME, Local 1369, AFL-CIO, Barre, Vt and Employer: Town of Barre, a consent election will be held by the Vermont Labor Relations Board among the fourteen (14) eligible municipal employees of the Town of Barre Public Works Department to determine whether or not the employees wish to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by: AFSCME, Local 1369, AFL-CIO, Barre, Vt or No Union.

This consent election will take place between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon at the Town of Barre Municipal Garage, Websterville, Vermont, on October 3, 1978.

And the following question having been voted on:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by: AFSCME, Local 1369, Barre, Vermont, or no union?

The Board certifies the results of voting on that question to be: AFSCME, Local 1369, AFL-CIO, Barre, Vermont - 11

No union - 2


One member of Public Works Department, included on the list of eligible voters retired prior to the election, therefore the total number of eligible voters was 13.


ORDER


