ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On July 29, 1982, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, through Edward E. Ryan, petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for an employee unit in the Highway Department of the Town of Milton. On August 19, 1982, Town Manager Ernest Laird filed notification of the Board of Selectmen's consent to an election.


The consent election was conducted by Labor Board Assistant Timothy J. Noonan on September 8, 1982, at the Clark Memorial Building. Edward Ryan observed the election for the union. Ernest Laird observed for the town. Five (5) votes were cast and the tally was:

No Union	2


As a result of this election, the Labor Relations Board hereby ORDERS the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees be CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative for all employees of the Town of Milton Highway Department, excluding Road Supervisor.


