ORDER OF NO CERTIFICATION

On October 6, 1982, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, through Edward E. Ryan, petitioned the Vermont Labor Relations Board for election of a collective bargaining representative for an employee unit for the road crew and sewer treatment workers of the Town of Danville. On November 19, 1982, the Town of Danville, through its attorney Ernest Tobias Balivet, filed an answer denying various assertions by the Union. Subsequent to a negotiated agreement on an appropriate bargaining unit, the parties filed a Stipulation of Facts and Consent to Election on January 5, 1983.

The consent election was conducted by Labor Board Assistant Timothy J. Noonan on January 25, 1983, at the Danville Town Garage. Attorney Balivet observed for the Town; Len Drown, an AFSCME representative, observed for the Union. Four votes were cast and the tally was:



The employees having determined that the Union is not the choice of the majority of the unit, it is hereby ORDERED that there be NO CERTIFICATION of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees as the exclusive bargaining representative for the road crew and sewer
