ORDER

On July 7, 1986, the South Burlington Water Pollution Control Employees Association ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among the chief operators, operators and mechanics employed by the South Burlington Water Pollution Control Department.

The City of South Burlington informed the Board on July 24, 1986, it agreed to a consent election. The Labor Relations Board conducted a representation election on August 19, 1986, in the Conference Room of the South Burlington Municipal Building. Timothy Noonan, Board Executive Director, conducted the election. Donald Duell observed the election on behalf of the Association. The City had no observer. All eligible employees voted. The results of the election were:




As a result of this election, it is hereby ORDERED:


