ORDER

WHEREAS the Vermont Labor Relations Board issued an Order on July 21, 1988, certifying AFSCME, AFL-CIO as the exclusive bargaining representative of all full-time employees of the Town of Castleton Highway Department and Police Department, excluding the Chief of Police and the Supervisor of the Highway Department; and

WHEREAS the Town of Castleton filed a unit clarification petition on May 25, 1989, indicating that the Town had decided to leave the Highway Department Supervisor position vacant, and requesting that the position of Highway Department Foreman be removed from the bargaining unit represented by AFSCME, AFL-CIO, as a supervisory employee; and


WHEREAS Ralph Crippen, AFSCME Representative, informed the Labor Relations Board on October 17, 1989, that AFSCME stipulated to the exclusion of the Highway Department Foreman position from the bargaining unit:

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Order of Certification issued by the Labor Relations Board on July 21, 1988, is AMENDED to provide that AFSCME, AFL-CIO, is CERTIFIED as the exclusive bargaining representative of all full-time employees of the Town of Castleton


Highway Department and Police Department, excluding the Chief of Police and the Foreman of the Highway Department.
