ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On March 26, 1991, IBEW Local 300 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among all employees of the water, street, and sewer department, excluding the assistant superintendent and superintendent, employed by the Village of Lyndonville ("Employer").

The Employer agreed to the conducting of a consent election among this group of employees. Linda McIntire, Labor Relations Board Legal Assistant, conducted an election on May 7, 1991, in the second floor conference room of the Lyndonville Village Office Building in Lyndonville, Vermont. Ernest Robbins, IBEW Local 300 Business Manager, was present as an observer for the Union. No Employer observer was present. All three eligible employees voted.

The results of the election were:




excluding the assistant superintendent and
