ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On March 16, 1992, IBEW local 300 ("Union") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, requesting an election among the employees of the street, sewer, electric and clerical departments, employed by Barton Village, Inc. ("Employer"). On March 25, 1992, the Union filed an Amended Petition in which it excluded supervisors from this proposed bargaining unit.

The Employer responded on April 17, 1992, and agreed to the conducting of a consent election among this group of employees. Linda McIntire, Labor Relations Specialist for the Vermont Labor Relations Board, conducted an election on May 6, 1992, in the Cafeteria of the Municipal Building on Main Street in Barton, Vermont. Susan Penharlow, Chair of the Barton Village Board of Trustees, observed for the Village. Ernest Robbins, IBEW Local 300 Business Manager, observed for the Union. All ten eligible employees voted. The results of the election were:




departments, excluding supervisors, employed by Barton Village,


