ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On April 11, 2014, the New England Police Benevolent Association (“Association”) filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent all full-time sworn police officers, including patrol officers and sergeants, of the Police Department of the Town of Williston (“Employer”), excluding the Police Chief and dispatchers. The Employer agreed to the conducting of a representation election among these employees.

On May 19, 2014, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election among these employees in the Community Meeting Room of the Williston Police Department. Tony Archinski, Association Representative, observed the election for the Association. The Employer had no observer. 13 of 14 eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they desire to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the New England Police Benevolent Association. The results of the election were:
