ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On January 9, 2001, the Essex-Caledonia NEA ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent the paraeducators, custodians, cooks and secretary employed by the Lunenburg Board of School Directors ("Employer"). On January 17, 2001, the Employer responded to the petition and agreed to the conducting of a consent election among these employees.

On March 12, 2001, Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election in the library of the Gilman Middle School. The Employer and the Association had no observer during balloting; Association Vice President Wayne Whitehill observed the counting of ballots. Fourteen of twenty eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Essex-Caledonia NEA. The results of the election were:


