ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On May 15, 2001, the Walden Teachers Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA ("Association") filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative to represent for exclusive bargaining purposes all paraeducators employed by the Walden School Board ("Employer"). On May 31, 2001, the Employer responded to the petition and agreed to the conducting of a consent election among all paraeducators.

On June 12, 2001, Vermont Labor Relations Board Executive Director Timothy Noonan conducted an election in the library of the Walden School, Walden, Vermont. Vermont-NEA Organizer Jason Serota-Winston observed the election for the Association. The Employer had no observer during the balloting; Walden School Principal Jeffrey Lindgren observed the counting of ballots. All six eligible employees voted. Employees were asked if they wished to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Walden Teachers Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is hereby ordered that the Walden Teachers Association/Vermont-NEA/NEA is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of all paraeducators employed by the Walden School Board.


