ORDER OF CERTIFICATION

On March 12, 2014, AFSCME Council 93, Local 1343, AFL-CIO ('Union') filed a Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative, seeking to add the Technical Support Specialists in the Technology Department of the Burlington School District ('Employer') to the existing bargaining unit of employees of the Employer represented by the Union.

The Employer responded to the petition on April 1, 2014, agreeing: 1) that the proposed addition to the bargaining unit is appropriate, and 2) to the conducting of an election among the Technical Support Specialists to determine whether they desire to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by the Union. Timothy Noonan, Executive Director of the Labor Relations Board, conducted an election on April 30, 2014, in Room 25, Burlington School District Central Office, 150 Colchester Avenue, Burlington. Michael Blair, Union Representative, was observer for the Union. Dolores Cox of the Human Resources Department of the Employer was observer for the Employer. Four eligible employees voted.

Employees were asked if they desire to be represented for exclusive bargaining purposes by AFSCME Council 93, Local 1343, AFL-CIO. The results of the election were:

As a result of this election, it is ordered that AFSCME Council 93, Local 1343, AFL-CIO, is certified as the exclusive bargaining representative of the Technical Support Specialists in the Technology Department of the Burlington School District, and these employees are added to the existing bargaining unit of Burlington School District employees represented by AFSCME Council 93, Local 1343, AFL-CIO.
