O R D E R

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on May 15, 1976.

1. Following Petition for Election of Collective Bargaining Representative and Answer, the parties stipulated for a consent election designating a bargaining unit consisting of the maintenance and custodial workers of the Employer.

2. On May 6, 1976, an election was conducted by secret ballot by Alfred J. Schmitt a member of the State Labor Relations Board. The employees were requested to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the Vermont State Employees Association, Inc.?


Thirteen employees were eligible to vote with twelve voting. The results of the vote were: 6, yes; 6, no.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that Vermont State Employees Association, Inc. may not be certified as the exclusive

hargaining representative for failure to attain 51% affirmative
vote of all votes cast pursuant to the provisions of 12 VSA 1224(e).
