CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on October 24, 1968.

1. On August 14, 1968, the parties filed with the State Labor Relations Board a Stipulation for a consent election of collective bargaining representative for a bargaining unit of employees of the Barre City School District designated as custodian, maintenance and grounds employees.

2. On October 14, 1968, an election was held at Spaulding High School in Barre, under the supervision of William Kemsley and John Boylan, members of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. The employees of the bargaining unit were asked to vote on the following questions:


Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, and its Local No. 1369.


The result of this vote was: Yes, 17; No, 2.


Now therefore it is hereby ORDERED that the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, Local No. 1369 is hereby certified as the collective bargaining representative of the custodian, maintenance and grounds employees of the Barre City School District. Said employees

shall constitute a bargaining unit.
