CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on April 16, 1973.

1. The parties filed with the State Labor Relations Board a Stipulation for a Consent Election of exclusive collective bargaining representative for a bargaining unit of the cafeteria employees of the school district for the Town of Barre, Vermont.

2. On April 12, 1973, an election was held in the Town of Barre, Vermont, under the supervision of Alfred J. Schmitt, member of the State Labor Relations Board.

3. Nine employees were eligible to vote and were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO.

Eight employees voted and all voted affirmative to the question posed.

NOW THEREFORE it is hereby ORDERED that the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all of the cafeteria employees of the School District for the Town of Barre, Vermont.
