CERTIFICATION ORDER

This matter came on for consideration before the State Labor Relations Board on November 18, 1974.

1. Findings of Fact and Order were issued by the Board dated October 3, 1974, wherein the Hazen Union Federation of Teachers, AFT, Local 3269, AFL-CIO was determined by the Board to be an eligible bargaining agent.

2. A bargaining unit was designated of employees of the Hazen Union School of Hardwick, Vermont performing the following duties: Maintenance, custodians, teacher's aides, cooks, library clerks, bus drivers, secretaries, kitchen workers and study hall monitors.

3. On November 13, 1974 an election by secret ballot was conducted by Alfred J. Schmitt, a member of the Board. The eligible employees were asked to vote on the following question:

Do you wish to be represented for exclusive collective bargaining purposes by the Hazen Union Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 3269, AFL-CIO?


Thirteen employees were eligible to vote. The result of the vote was yes, 12; no, 1.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the Hazen Union Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 3269, AFL-CIO is hereby certified as the exclusive collective bargaining agent for a bargaining unit consisting of the following employees: Maintenance, custodians, teacher's aides, cooks, library clerks, bus drivers, secretaries, kitchen workers and study hall monitors.
